- Items are subject to the terms and conditions stipulated by the donors. All services must be used within the time limits stated or WITHIN ONE YEAR (by April 9, 2012). Please do not request extensions beyond the one-year restriction for trips.
- When purchases are to be redeemed after the auction, the purchaser should contact the donor within 4 weeks to make arrangements.
